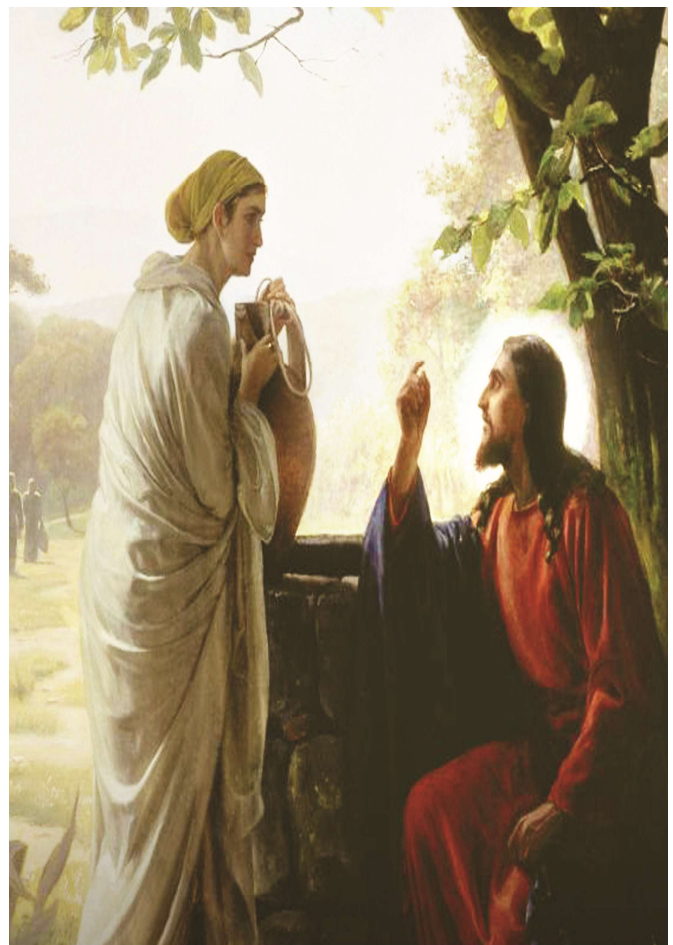

Pro-Life - Pope John Paul II made clear the Church's teaching on providing food and fluids as normal care. "I should like particularly to underline how the administration of water and food, even when provided by artificial means, always represents a natural means of preserving life, not a medical act. Its use, furthermore, should be considered, in principle, ordinary and proportionate, and as such morally obligatory, insofar as and until it is seen to have attained its proper finality, which in the present case consists in providing nourishment to the patient and alleviation of his suffering." *Pray that all those who find life burdensome may be helped to believe in the sanctity and importance of each human life.*

WIELKI POST - W tym okresie rozważamy Mękę Pana Jezusa i przez pokutę, post i umartwienie pragniemy podziękować Bogu za zesłanie na ziemię swego Syna, który poprzez cierpienia i zbawczą śmierć na krzyżu okupił świat. Zróbmy postanowienia poprawy i korzystajmy z sakramentu pokuty. Bierzmy też udział w nabożeństwach wielkopostnych.

Przypominamy, że każdego katolika, który ukończył 14 rok życia obowiązuje powstrzymanie się od pokarmów mięsnych w Środę Popielcową i wszystkie piątki Wielkiego Postu.
