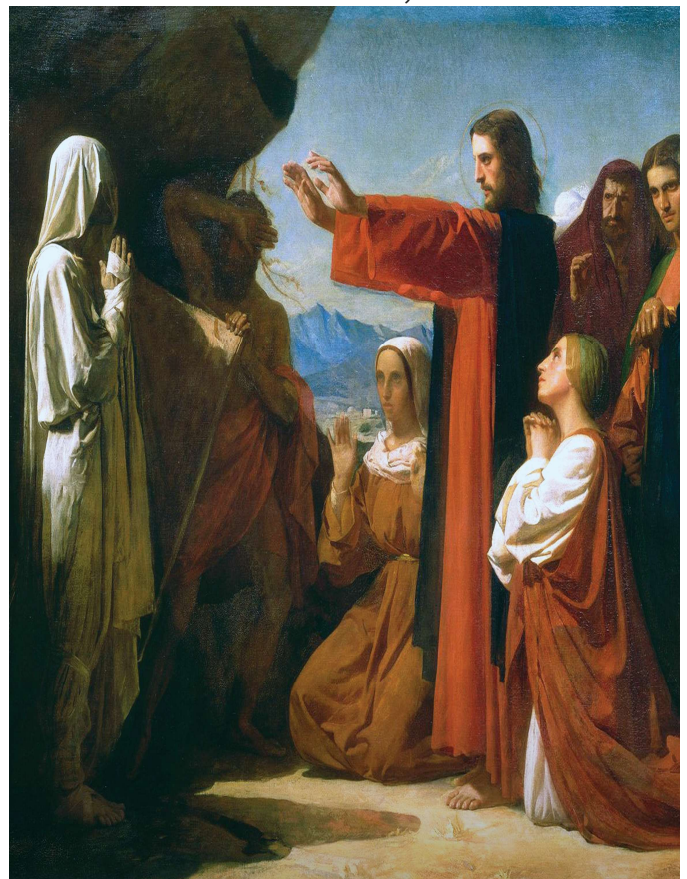

Dzisiejsza druga składka jest przeznaczona na kwiaty oraz dekorację kościoła na Wielkanoc. Serdecznie dziękujemy za ofiarność.

WIELKI POST - W tym okresie rozważamy Mękę Pana Jezusa i przez pokutę, post i umartwienie pragniemy podziękować Bogu za zesłanie na ziemię swego Syna, który poprzez cierpienia i zbawczą śmierć na krzyżu okupił świat. Zróbmy postanowienia poprawy i korzystajmy z sakramentu pokuty. Bierzmy też udział w nabożeństwach wielkopostnych.

Przypominamy, że każdego katolika, który ukończył 14 rok życia obowiązuje powstrzymanie się od pokarmów mięsnych w Środę Popielcową i wszystkie piątki Wielkiego Postu.
