On **Holy Thursday**, we recall the events of the *Lord's Supper* when the Eucharist and the priesthood were given to the Church.

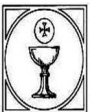
On **Good Friday**, we recall *Christ's death* on the cross and venerate the instrument of our salvation.

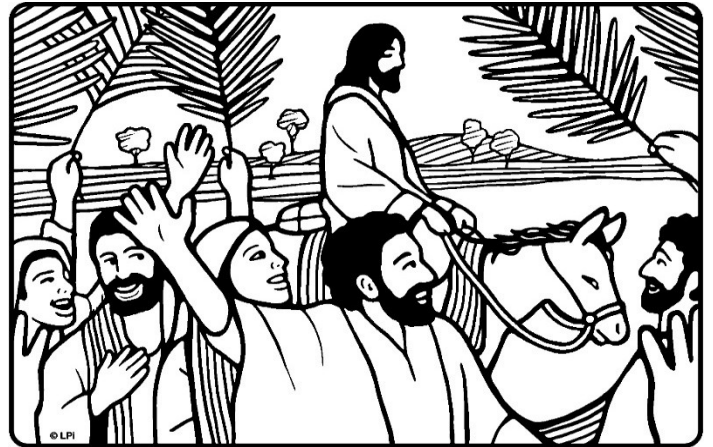
